Town Council Update – April 8, 2010

- Silver Meadows has made the water main connection. We started charging and testing their main line and found a broken 8" water line. They are in the process of fixing it so we can continue.
- The airport service contract has been signed and finalized.
- We have made the water and sewer taps for the new city hall.
- The Children's Shelter has started the activity center and maintenance buildings. I have been up working with them on under slab plumbing inspections.
- In the absence of Kently, worked with our road grader, John, and worked out a schedule for the maintenance of our roads.
- Came in during the Sunday snow storm and cleared the roads of snow drifts to make them passable.
- Started to us the tractor with boom arm mower, but found it to have several maintenance issues that need to be repaired. It has been fixed and is being put into service this week.
- Worked with Gary to get the park mowed before the Easter holiday.
- Still working on the Highfill to Centerton service area sale.
- We have had a motor go out on one of the pumps at the sewer plant. I am trying to get it covered under warranty. Will know more later, possibly by the council meeting.
- In your packets this month are two ordinances expanding the number of board members to serve on the water and sewer boards. Currently, we only have three members per board. Since both boards have the same individuals and basically serve as one board, it makes it nearly impossible to conduct regular business if one of the members is absent. Steve has researched it and we can easily add two more members each giving us a better chance to have a quorum at the meetings.
- Will be attending the annual Water/Wastewater Manager's conference before the next council meeting.
