Town Council Update – December 15, 2009

- Back in late spring, we started installing the recirculation system on the water tower. This was done to help eliminate our problem with Trihalomethanes. At the same time, we worked with the Health Dept. collecting daily and monthly data on the water quality. On August 17th, we brought the recirculation system online. We started seeing results almost immediately. I have attached comparison charts showing our progress. Also note that our 3rd quarter Readings as well as our Running Annual Average is the lowest it's been in three years. This is great news as it gets us out of trouble with the ADH and EPA.
- As a result of adding this recirculation system to our tower, the Arkansas Health Department has required us to get a Treatment Two license. I got a "T1" license back in the summer and last week went to school and received the required "T2" license.
- At the beginning of this past month, I attended class in Fayetteville and became certified as a Cross Connection Control Specialist. The information taught in class will be very useful for our Backflow and Cross Connection Control Program.
- Still working with Silver Meadows as they lay and connect sewer lines.
- Fayetteville Mechanical has started installing the water mains at the new Children's Shelter. NEC will begin laying the sewer lines shortly. Continuing to work with both.
- Have made 3 new water taps and 1 new sewer tap this past month. Working on the possibility of 3 more sewer taps.
- Still working with the airport to finalize contract renewal. May have more to report at council meeting.
- With classes and the holidays, have been out of the office more than normal and do not have much more to report.
