Town Council Update – February 11, 2010

- As you may have expected, the weather has had us in survival mode for most of the month. Even so, we have been able to get a few things accomplished.
- Weather has stopped the work at Silver Meadows. They have poured a few man-holes as the weather has permitted.
- The weather has also stopped Fayetteville Mechanical from finishing installing the water mains at the new Children's Shelter. As soon as it warms up enough, they will complete their work and we will begin the testing phase.
- Northwest Excavation Company has completed the sewer line installation. We have performed all the necessary tests and it has passed and is ready to bring online with the facility.
- Have sent the airport the initial draft of the contract for renewal. Attached is a copy along with the cover letter I sent to them.
- In your packets will be an ordinance approving the sale of part of our system to the City of Centerton. We have been working on this for some time now, and all parties at the state level have approved it. Once we approve this ordinance, the contract between us and Centerton will be sent to them to make it official between us.
- This year we had made plans to transfer to a new and updated billing software. The old program was 10 years old and unable to be upgraded any more. Since we have made changes to the rate structure, now was the time to change. I have been in the process of transferring customer information to the new software. Those of you who receive water bills will see a difference on the next bill.
- In regards to speaking with ANRC about deferment of our loan we spoke of last month, I will be working on that as the year goes on and keep you informed as I go.
- Finally, Steve has reviewed and drafted the ordinance to purchase the tractor for the Town.
